A volunteer is defined as a person who receives no payment or expense reimbursement for their services.

As of June 2015 the USSF no longer offers a D License & D Certificate (formally State License). Through the four stages candidates will either score enough points to earn a USSF D License or a Provisional D. Any candidate that receives a provisional pass must return to complete the Deliberate Practice Phase (two training session & self reviews) & Performance Review in order to obtain the USSF D. Coaches that receive a Provisional D have 12 months to upgrade.
